Open call for Co-Creation Workshop/Residency with VestAndPage.

As part of Hamar Performance Festival taking place in October 2023

VestAndPage offer a 6-days Co-Creation Workshop/Residency including a public sharing.

Application deadline June 23th

Join us for this exciting In-person Co-Creation in a 6-days residency in Hamar. This opportunity is open to emerging and established artists for a wide range of artistic practises. We are inviting dedicated individuals to collaborate with VestAndPage and other artists in a collective performance opera. Collective performance operas are complexly layered collaborative live performance works created through medium- to long-term intensive co-creation processes by VestAndPage in collaboration with other artists. These live works are presented only once and are based on the unique contribution that each of the invited collaborators brings into the work.

VestAndPage's performance art works and research range from live performance cycles and collective performance operas, over performance-based films and writings to temporary artistic community projects. They are the founders and artistic directors of the Venice International Performance Art Week. Currently, they are in post-production for "STRATA", a performance-based feature film on Deep Time and "momentum", an ongoing series of videos that hosts existential conversations with people from the arts, culture and science. They are performing "1 9 Monologue", an autobiographical performance monologue about the body as a home of pathogens, and "Lost Matter", a ritual on the climate emergency. <https://www.vest-and-page.de/>
